- No Credit is awarded for the CLEP examinations in **Foreign Languages** or **Business**, or for **DANTES DSST** examinations.
- Credit for CLEP/DANTES examinations is awarded by the Transfer Credit evaluation Unit in the Office of Undergraduate Admissions and Financial Aid. Contact: 313.577-3577.
- Credit will not be awarded for CLEP scores on the basis of their appearance on the transcript of another institution.
- No more than 32 hours of CLEP credit (or a combination of CLEP, AP and IB) may be used toward a WSU degree.
- All scale scores for the General Examinations in English Composition, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Science, and Social Science will be reported as a two-digit number. The score scale for the general exams has switched from 200-800 to 20-80. In addition, the General Examinations are now Subject Examinations based on the College Board's July 2001 revisions.
